Jamie Paris's essay both establishes and theorizes the instability of whiteness within *The Changeling*. Situating the play's anxieties about 'bad blood' within the context of Spanish conceptions of limpieza de sangre (purity of blood), Paris demonstrates that Beatrice-Joanna's whiteness is inherently conditional, a conditionality that reveals the fictionality of whiteness in early modernity (and beyond).
